



## Firefighter Chilli Cook-Off 2011

- Contest to take place **Saturday October 1<sup>st</sup>, from 12 pm – 4 pm**, set up time is 11 am in front of the Court House on Cross Street.
- You will be provided with (per team of 4-6): tent, 1 table, 1 tablecloth, 1 propane burner, 1 propane tank, 1 large crock-pot, 1 small crock-pot. Napkins, spoons, and sample serving dishes will be supplied for the event.
- Each team will receive a chili starter kit (\$75 value); any spices or secret ingredients are the responsibility of individual team. **Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, at 11 am, teams will be required to pick up their starter kit from festival organizers at Country Corner Market, 686 Quaker Road in Welland.** A team representative will be in a promotional photo taken at that time.
- Teams will arrive with their chili fully cooked and stored in a proper cooler; use the propane burner to get the chili to 180° (use a probe thermometer to confirm proper temperature, not supplied). Contest begins at noon.
- Teams will serve chili from supplied large crock-pot; each team will take home their complementary Crock-pot, along with a small crock-pot (Little Dipper) that will be used for donations.
- 1<sup>st</sup> place winners will be determined by the amount of donations collected. The general public will make donations to the chili they like best. All donations collected will go to the Niagara Region's Children's Safety Village.
- Teams are responsible to supply their own hand washing stations, disposable gloves, serving ladles, and decorations for their booth. You can advertise your own events at your space (calendars, drives, shows). Teams are responsible to clean & tear down their booth starting @ 4 pm (or once chili is gone), and leave the site the same way they entered it.

**Ingredients provided by Country Corner:** 2 cloves of garlic, 2 bags of onions, 10 red peppers, 1 can of 100 oz kidney beans, 15 lbs of ground beef, 4 cans of 100 oz diced tomatoes, 1 large can of tomatoe sauce.
